ICF Paris Ile de France is pleased to announce our upcoming ICF Paris International event with Dr Alison Hodge, coming in from London especially for this event. She will share the findings of her 2014 Doctoral Research Inquiry for the first time in France. Her thesis "What goes on in Coaching Supervision to the end of enhancing the coaching profession" is only the third piece of research at this level in the world.

The breakfast meeting will allow you to fully enter into this topic and to share and learn about the ways in which supervision can support our needs as coaches.

As Dr Hodge says “Reflecting on practice on a one-to-one basis is extremely useful and highly valued. But what does it really involve? Is it solely a one-to-one dialogue with a qualified other? What else enables coaches to practice safely, ethically and professionally? How do we as coaches keep ourselves fit for purpose?”

Key issues brought to light by Dr Hodge’s research include:

- The power of the supervision relationship
- Creating the core conditions of adult learning
- Elements that need to be attended to in supervision

Dr Alison Hodge is an EMCC accredited coach at Master Practitioner level and an APECS accredited Executive Coaching Supervisor. She has been working with individuals and groups to facilitate learning and change throughout her career and she delights in the power of the relationship to heighten individuals’ personal awareness and tap into their massive capabilities and talents.

She graduated with her Professional Doctorate in Coaching Supervision at Middlesex University in July 2014.
